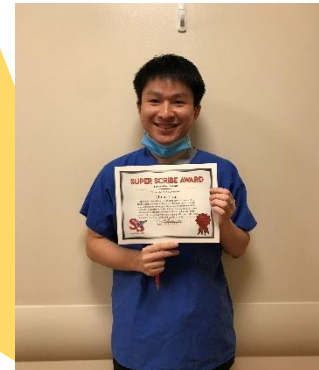

News Article: Are Human Scribes Truly Effective for Safe EHR Documentation?

“Having it done in real time, there’s no substitute for it,” said an anonymous respondent. “Dragon doesn’t do this for you. You have to tell Dragon what to put in, and then you still have to go back in and edit it. And you don’t have to tell a scribe everything that needs to go in there. They’re watching and listening and putting this information in there, and then it’s getting edited in a much more truncated time frame.”
