

On March 30th we celebrate National Doctors Day, a "holiday" which, interestingly



News Article: Humans Top Digital Scribes For Better EHR Documentation

Clinicians scored digital scribes well behind hybrid models and human scribes when it came to EHR documentation. Human scribes still trump digital scribes in EHR documentation, according to a study published in the *Association for Computing Machinery Digital Library*.

A digital scribe is not currently capable of widespread adoption because of a lack of accuracy, completeness, and medical synthesis, clinician respondents said.
